# Sway

- A drop-in replacement of I3WM
- Written for Wayland
- Based on wlroots (Wayland compositor)
- First commit: 04/08/2015
- First Fedora version: (v0-1.20160214git016a774): 14/02/2016
- First release (v0.1): 24/03/2016

#### Fedora <38

- Multiple people had their own Fedora "Spin"
- In May 2022 we decided to create an official Spin in F37
- We did missed the F37 window

# Fedora Sway Spin packages

- sway, swaybg, swayidle, swaylock
- dunst (notification daemon)
- foot (terminal emulator)
- slurp, grim (screeenshots)
- imv (image viewer)
- kanshi (dynamic output configurator)
- mpv (media player)
- Thunar, thunar-archive-plugin (file manager)
- sddm, sddm-x11 (login manager)

#### Sericea name


Pronunciation: (CL) [se.ri.ke.a] (EL) [se.ri.tfe.a])

Fedora Sericea comes from Terminalia Sericea and has been chosen due to the many connections with this project:

- Sericea starts with "S", like Sway.
- Terminalia Sericea is a tree. So is ostree.
- Terminalia Sericea is also known as Silverleaf. Silverleaf was one of the top contenders for the project name of what later became Fedora Silverblue.
- If you stare at a Terminalia Sericea for a while, you'll eventually start noticing similarities with the Sway logo.




